Discussion:

Councilman Darius Crump moved suspend the rules to consider authorizing Mr. Barker an additional \$52,000.00 to cover the additional road quotes he received. Councilwoman Sandra Cook seconded the Motion. The Motion failed for lack of unanimously vote.

Mayor Pro-Tem James Chapman moved to accept council minutes 3-4-2025, as written by the city clerk. Mayor Daryl McIntyre seconded the Motion. The Motion passed with five yeses, and one abstaining (Councilman Jonathan Ray was not present).
