Brett Isom of the Regional Planning Committee of Greater Birmingham explained the different steps of redistricting.

Brett Isom explained how he was able to come up with the redistricting option one, and that it was a population-based map.

District one: 1056 population District two: 991 population District three: 1112 population District four: 956 population District five: 991 population

Janice McIntyre, a long-time Margaret resident, expressed concerns about the redistricting map based on eliminating districts 2 and 3. The option one map combines districts 2 and 3.

Patricia Patterson, a long-time resident of Margaret, questioned redistricting map option one and inquired whether or not the map represented growth. Mrs. Patterson requested to look at the current districts' map.

Mayor Daryl McIntyre informed the residents that this hearing was only for informative purposes. The Council will consult Mr. Isom concerning a final map addressing the residents' concerns.

Councilman Matthew Tortorice moved to proceed with option one redistricting map presented by Mr. Isom, with an effective date after the municipal elections. Councilman Tortorice was informed that
