Mayor Pro-Tem James Chapman made the Motion to accept the prepared agenda.

Councilwoman Sandra Cook seconded the Motion. Councilman Matthew

franchise agreement, employee raises and to discuss the organizational ordinance.

Police Chief Fields gave an update on the police vests. The amount of \$8,000 was previously approved for this purchase. They received a grant for all except two vests. They will have to spend \$2,010 of the \$8,000 for the two vests.
